3. APPLICATION No & ROLL No

Each Candidate is allotted a 5-digit *Application No* (marked on the Postal/ On-Line Application Form).

Roll No is of 9-digit comprising

- i) 2-digit Discipline Code followed by
- ii) 2-digit Centre Code and followed by
- iii) 5-digit *Application No*.

This Roll No. will have to be entered on the Answer Sheet provided at the time of examination.

Only *Application No* should be quoted for all future correspondence.

4. INSTRUCTIONS FOR WRITTEN TEST

Candidates are required to fulfill all '**Eligibility Criteria**' as specified in the OCES/ DGFS-2010 Advertisement.

Candidates are required to make their own arrangements for boarding, lodging and transport at the Test Venue.

Candidates should bring the following items to the

Written Test venue. (i) **Copy of Application Form, (with photograph) (ii) Guidelines for Written Test (this sheet) and (iii) Pen, HB/ 2B Pencils, Eraser and Sharpener.**

Books/ notes, calculators, pagers, mobile phones, etc are **not allowed** in the Examination Hall. The examination paper will have hundred multiple choice questions..

Candidates should not correspond with the authorities of the Written Test Venue.

Dates of Written Test, if changed in case of unavoidable circumstances, will be announced on the BARC web-site (www.hrdbarc.gov.in).

Candidates can check their Selection Interview eligibility status by using name/ Application No. on the same web-site from May 25, 2010. If a candidate is called for Selection Interview, the reporting date and time will be indicated. Individual call letters will also be posted.

5. INFORMATION ABOUT WRITTEN TEST

An Optical Mark Reader Answer Sheet (**OMRAS**) will be given initially on the commencement of the Test. All applicable entries should be made on Side-1 of the OMRAS as per instructions given. The Question Paper shall be given at 1015/ 1415/1730 Hrs.

The Written Test is of two-hour duration and will have **separate Question Paper for each discipline**. It comprises objective type questions and each will generally have 4 choices of answers (one of which is correct) namely A, B, C & D. A correct answer will fetch

3 marks while a wrong answer will lead to -1 marks.

- Use of calculator, slide rule, log tables, notes, books etc, is **not** allowed.
- Blank sheets for rough work will be provided.
- Candidates will be allowed to leave the examination hall only 100 minutes after commencement of Test.
- Question Paper, OMRAS and rough working papers to be handed over to the Invigilator before leaving.
